

Pursuant to RSA 189:76, the Exeter Region Cooperative School District hereby provides this required report to voters on school expenses. The statute requires school districts to publicly disclose specified financial information related to educational spending and administrative compensation as part of the annual budget process. All applicable financial data has been adjusted for inflation, as required by RSA 189:76, so that all figures are presented in today's dollars.

Under this statute, the district is now required to provide the public with clear, long-term data regarding how taxpayer funds are allocated. Our new report includes:

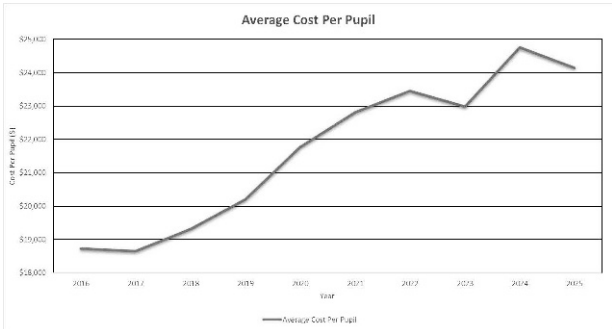
- **10-Year Comparisons:** Graphs showing trends in cost-per-

pupil, teacher salaries, and administrator pay. Per the RSA, these figures are adjusted for inflation so the community can see true spending changes over time.

- **Administrative Salaries:** A list of actual compensation for the highest-paid positions, including Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents, Business Administrators, and Coordinators of diversity, equity and inclusion.
- **Public Access:** As mandated by law, this information is available for review at least one week before the budget is adopted.

The report is available at the SAU Office, posted at the school building, and on our website. We encourage residents to review these materials as we prepare for the upcoming fiscal year.
